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SHAUL G. MASSRY DISTINGUISHED LECTURE

This lectureship was established to honor Dr. Shaul G. Massry for his scientific achievements and his contributions to the kidney health care community and to the National Kidney Foundation. The 2016 honored lecture is **Linda Fried, MD, MPH**. Dr. Fried will be presenting on "Lessons Learned from VA NEPHRON-D " on Thursday, April 28.



Linda Fried, MD, MPH is staff nephrologist at VAPHS and Professor of Medicine, Epidemiology and Clinical and Translational Science at the University of Pittsburgh. She received her medical degree from Mount Sinai School of Medicine and trained in Internal Medicine at Columbia-Presbyterian Medical Center in New York. She subsequently trained in Nephrology at University of Pittsburgh Medical Center and earned a Masters of Public Health at the University of Pittsburgh. In 1996, she joined the faculty at VAPHS and the University of Pittsburgh.

Her research involves both epidemiologic studies and clinical trials. Her research focuses in three areas: the association of kidney disease with heart disease, the association of kidney disease in outcomes in older individuals and progression of diabetic nephropathy. Dr Fried was chair of VA NEPHRON D, a multicenter, VA Cooperative Study that studied whether combination of losartan plus lisinopril would slow progression of proteinuric diabetic nephropathy. She currently serves as chair of the Steering Committee for the NIDDK sponsored CKD Pilot Consortium. This consortium is testing three interventions in earlier phase CKD studies with a goal to inform a large scale phase three study on progression of kidney disease.
